

## **Lesson 5. In the beginning, God created...**

Equipment: flour, salt, oil, paper, pens, Bibles

Activity: Make Playdough and create something.

<u>Ingredients:</u> 1 cup salt, 2 cups water, 4 teaspoons cream of tartar (adds to elasticity and slows crystal formation, but not essential), 2 cups flour, 2 tablespoons oil, 1 teaspoon vanilla essence (optional for fragrance), few drops of food colouring.

Method: Mix together in pot. Stir constantly over low heat until mixture comes away from sides of pot and has turned into dough. Knead until smooth. Store in a cool place in an air-tight container.






Genesis 1—2:3
